



## RING SIZER :

Measure your finger with a printed paper sizer

### Instructions:

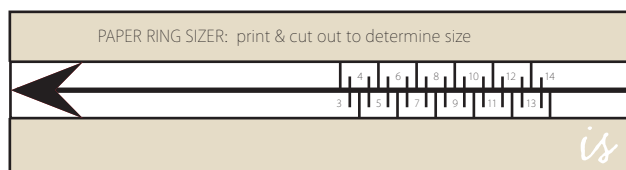
Please read all instructions carefully to ensure accurate measurements.

Before measuring your finger, please review the general guidelines for ring-sizing on our website.

1. Print out this page, making sure that your printer's scaling is turned "off" or set to "none".
2. Check to see that the scale of the sizer on this printed page is accurate by measuring the red "reference line" below. It should measure exactly 2cm (20mm).
3. Cut out the complete beige-colored box below, then fold back the top and bottom portions of the beige area along the printed measuring tape, so that only the white area is visible. This will give some rigidity and structure to the paper sizer.
4. Encircle the appropriate finger with the paper strip to approximate a ring.
5. Fit the strip snugly to your finger and eliminate any slack left in the paper strip. The sizer must be fit snugly in order to produce an accurate size.
6. The point of the arrow should point to your ring size. You can round to the nearest half-size.

Reference line: measure this reference line to assure accuracy
