


RING COMPARISON CHART:

measure an existing ring to determine its size

Instructions:

1. Print out this template to compare your existing ring.
2. Check to see that the scale of the sizer on the printed page is accurate by measuring the red "reference line" below. **It should measure 2cm (20mm).**
3. Place your ring on the template and compare.
4. When comparing, look at the hole inside your ring (i.e. the inner circumference). On the printed page, you should be able to see the white area inside that circle and all or part of the black line corresponding to the inner circumference of the ring, but you SHOULD NOT be able to see the template's colored background.
5. Find the closest match and take the ring size from the number printed inside the corresponding circle.

measure this reference line to assure accuracy  = 20mm
